Belmont

- Supported efforts to fund construction of the new, state-of-the-art Belmont Library.
- Major supporter of Notre Dame de Namur University; serves on the School of Sciences Advisory Board and as an Adjunct Professor of Public Administration.
- Assisted efforts to fund construction of the Bicycle/Pedestrian crossing over Highway 101

Brisbane

- Voted in favor of a resolution supporting the Endangered Species Act, which protects several vulnerable species inhabiting San Bruno Mountain Park.
- Voted to purchase 25 acres of land along the eastern edge of San Bruno Mountain and donate it to San Bruno Mountain State and County Park for preservation.
- Supported the Peninsula Habitat for Humanity's Brisbane Project, which culminated in the completion of the organization's 100th home in San Mateo County.

Burlingame

- Performs an annual magic show at Our Lady of Angels elementary school.
- Passed legislation requiring all hospitals in the County, including Mills Peninsula Health Center, to serve as certified stroke centers. Certified stroke centers deliver timely, life-saving care to those who suffer from the onset of a stroke.
- Led the County's successful effort to purchase the Burlingame Long Term Care Facility, preventing it from closure.
- Led a local effort to bring Virgin America to San Francisco International Airport.

Daly City

- Passed legislation requiring all hospitals in the County, including Mills Peninsula Health Center, to serve as certified stroke centers. Certified stroke centers deliver timely, life-saving care to those who suffer from the onset of a stroke.
- Supported efforts to secure funding and permits for the new Boys & Girls Club.
- Opened 'County kiosks' at Daly City Hall to direct residents toward county services.

Foster City

- Founded and sponsored the Foster City Library's Dad & Me at the Library event.
- Supported funding for Homework Centers in libraries.
- MC of the Foster City Chamber of Commerce's 2006 *Season of Sharing* event, which raised money for the SoundWave Center for Hearing Impaired Children.

Half Moon Bay & Coastside

- Supported the County's acquisition of Mirada Surf in El Granada to preserve the area as a public park.
- Supported and voted for the Mid-Peninsula Regional Open Space District's expansion efforts on the Coast.
- Began a public outreach process to solicit the community's input to craft a watershed protection ordinance.
- Major supporter of local efforts to promote the Devil's Slide Tunnel as a Highway 1 alternative to a bypass over Montara Mountain. Engineers broke ground on the Tunnel alternative in 2007.
- Longtime supporter of the agricultural community and the San Mateo County Farm Bureau's efforts to promote the local agricultural industry.
- Works closely with the Resource Conservation District to ensure proper oversight of the region's environmental quality standards.

Highlands

- Worked with the community to postpone sewer rate increases until a more financially sound agreement could be arranged
- Approved the County's conservation easement ordinance, which requires a conservation easement upon subdivision of Resource Management-zoned lands.

Hillsborough

- Supported funding for Crystal Springs Road improvements.

Millbrae

- Voted to allocate \$102,000 in County funds to aid Millbrae's transition to the County's centralized emergency dispatch center.
- Supported efforts to fund construction of the Millbrae BART extension.

Pacifica

- Co-authored and secured passage of an ordinance banning smoking in County parks.
- Supported efforts to secure funding for the preservation of the Pacifica Pier.
- Voted to provide additional funding to keep the Sanchez and Sharp Park libraries both open.

San Bruno

- Opposed Wal-Mart's efforts to expand into the city.
- Supported efforts to fund construction of the San Bruno BART extension.

San Mateo

- Worked with local officials to relocate a homeless shelter formerly adjacent to an elementary school into a new site on SamTrans-owned land near San Francisco International Airport.
- Opposed and successfully fought against statewide efforts to allow slot machine gambling at horse racing venues.
- Supported initiatives to construct affordable housing for teachers near the College of San Mateo campus
- Supported efforts to build Transit-Oriented housing developments along the El Camino Real corridor.
