## **Hill Campaign Moving “Full Speed Ahead” Toward June Primary**

San Mateo, CA – With the defeat of Proposition 93, the term limits modification initiative, Assemblyman Gene Mullen, 19<sup>th</sup> District, will be “termed out” at the end of this year, San Mateo County Supervisor Jerry Hill has now kicked his campaign into higher gear.

Out of respect for the exceptional work of Assemblyman Mullin, Supervisor Jerry Hill had committed to suspend his campaign if Proposition 93 were approved which would have allowed Mullin to run for re-election.

“Gene Mullin is an outstanding legislator and a valued friend. I look forward to his leadership in Sacramento during the rest of his term. We need his leadership as we grapple with the budget crisis, healthcare reform, education, and other critical issues impacting our community, and all of California,” said Hill.

Faced with the uncertainty of Proposition 93’s impact on Mullin’s ability to run for a fourth term, Hill decided to organize an aggressive campaign from the very beginning just in case. “When you look at the local endorsements I have received from the twelve cities in the District, including 11 of 12 Mayors and 41 of 48 City Councilmembers, combined with the wide financial support I have received from a broad cross section of San Mateo County, I feel extremely grateful and positive about our campaign. We’ve been working at full speed all along and we’ll keep up that pace right through to June 3rd,” said Hill.

**ABOUT JERRY HILL** - Jerry Hill was elected to the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors in June 1998, to represent the 2<sup>nd</sup> District, which includes San Mateo, Foster City, and Belmont. He was re-elected to the Board in March 2002 and June 2006. Previously, Jerry served on the City Council of the City of San Mateo from 1991 to 1998,

serving as Mayor in 1994. He is currently serving as an Adjunct Professor in Public Policy at Notre Dame de Namur University. Jerry lives in the City of San Mateo with his wife Sky. Jerry has lived in San Mateo County for 38 years.

He holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree in History & a Minor in Political Science from the University of California at Berkeley, as well as a Lifetime Secondary Teaching Credential from San Francisco State University.

**ABOUT THE 19<sup>TH</sup> ASSEMBLY DISTRICT** - The 19<sup>th</sup> Assembly District is home to 423,391 residents and includes the cities and communities of Belmont, Brisbane, Burlingame, portions of Daly City and El Granada, Foster City, Half Moon Bay, Hillsborough, Millbrae, Montara, Moss Beach, Pacifica, San Bruno, San Mateo, and South San Francisco. The 19<sup>th</sup> District is currently represented by Assemblyman Gene Mullin who will be termed out of office in 2008.
